Outline:

Module 1: Icebreakers and Team Dynamics

- Introduction to the training's goals and expectations.
- Icebreaker activities to not only break the ice but also unveil individual strengths and interests.
- Team-building games emphasizing collaboration, communication, and problem-solving.

Module 2: Communication Excellence

- Delve into the neuroscience of communication and its impact on team dynamics.
- Interactive communication styles assessment to better understand individual and team preferences.
- Role-playing scenarios to practice assertive communication and active listening.

Hands-on Activity: Conduct a mock team meeting where participants must navigate through a challenging scenario, applying the communication skills learned.

Module 3: Problem-solving in Teams

- Explore different problem-solving methodologies, including design thinking and agile approaches.
- Group exercises to simulate real-world problem-solving situations, allowing participants to apply learned strategies.
- Analyse case studies of successful team problem-solving in various industries.

Closing Session: Reflection and Action Planning

- Group discussion on the application of newfound skills in day-to-day work.
- Small group action planning sessions to outline specific strategies for implementing learned concepts in the workplace.
